## Subscribing to an Enhanced Podcast

The Tegrity course is available as an enhanced podcast. Subscribing to an enhanced podcast lets you listen to your classes on your iPod or using iTunes on your computer.

**To subscribe to an Enhanced Audio Podcast:**

1. On the *Class Recordings* page, select a class and click **iPod**. The *Subscribe to podcast* dialog box appears.

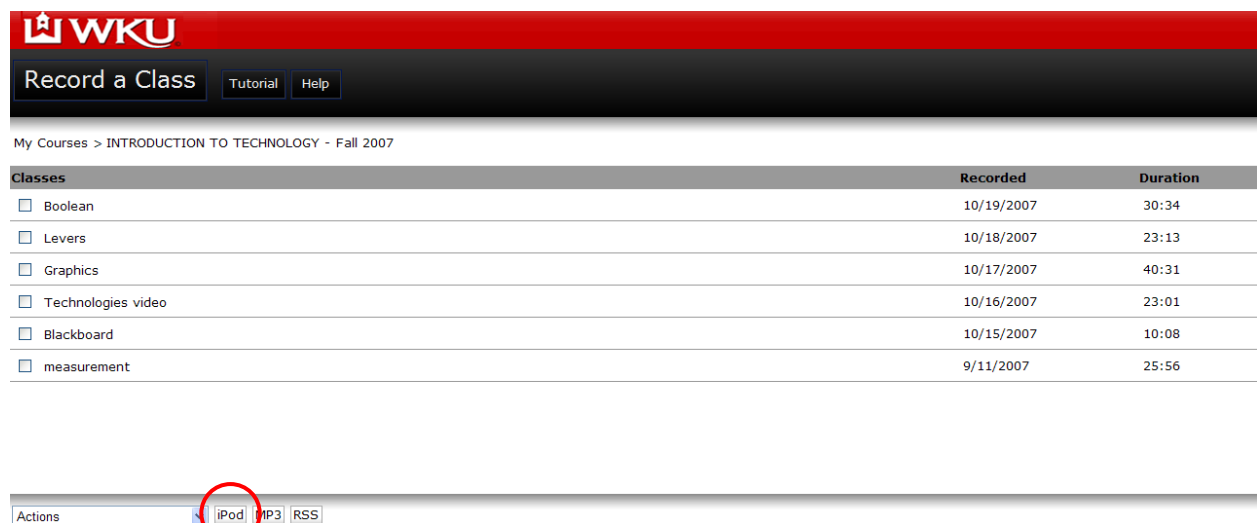


Figure 1: Class Recording Page

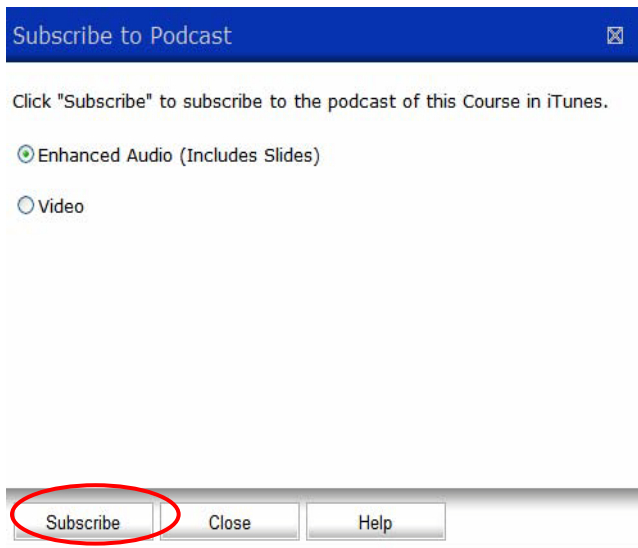


Figure 2: Subscribe to podcast Dialog Box

2. Select **Enhanced Audio (Includes Slides)**.
3. Click **Subscribe**. iTunes opens and displays the podcast.

### To subscribe to an MP3 podcast

1. On the *Class Recordings* page, select a class and click **MP3**. The *Subscribe to podcast* dialog box appears.

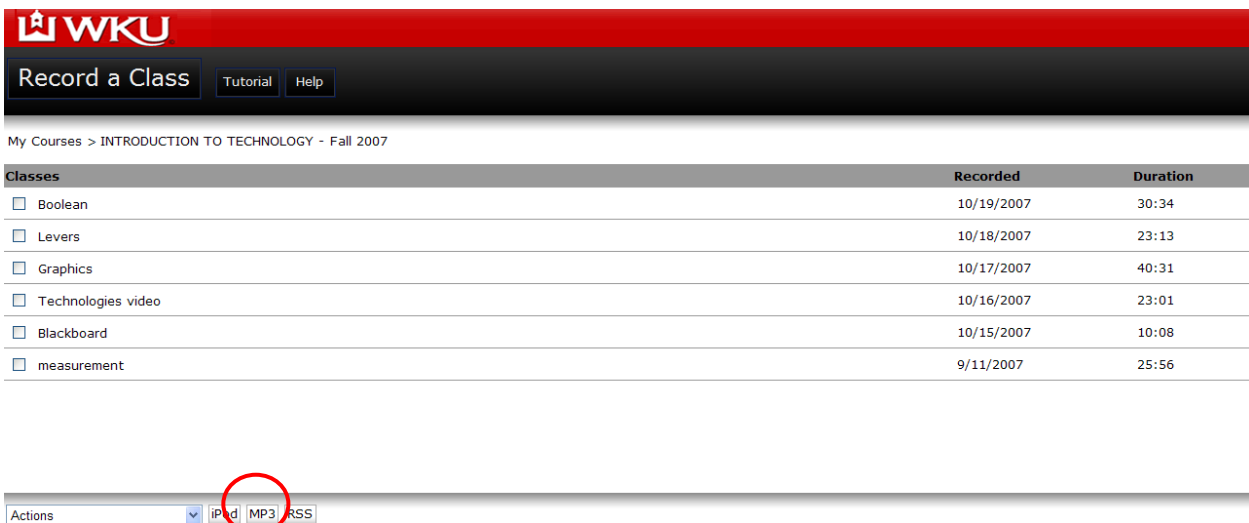


Figure 4: Class Recording Page

2. Select the **Copy to Clipboard** button.

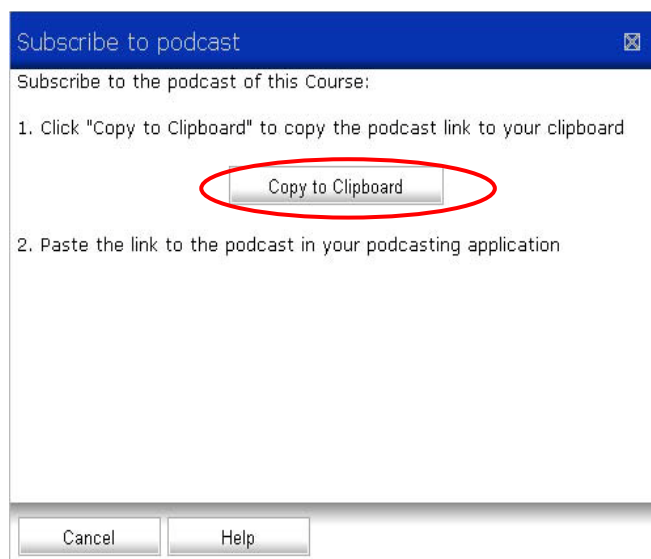


Figure 5: Subscribe to MP3 Dialog Box

3. Open a new web browser and paste the information into the address bar.

## Subscribing to a Video Podcast

To subscribe to a video podcast:

1. On the *Class Recordings* page, select a class and click **iPod**. The *Subscribe to podcast* dialog box appears.

2. Select the Video option.

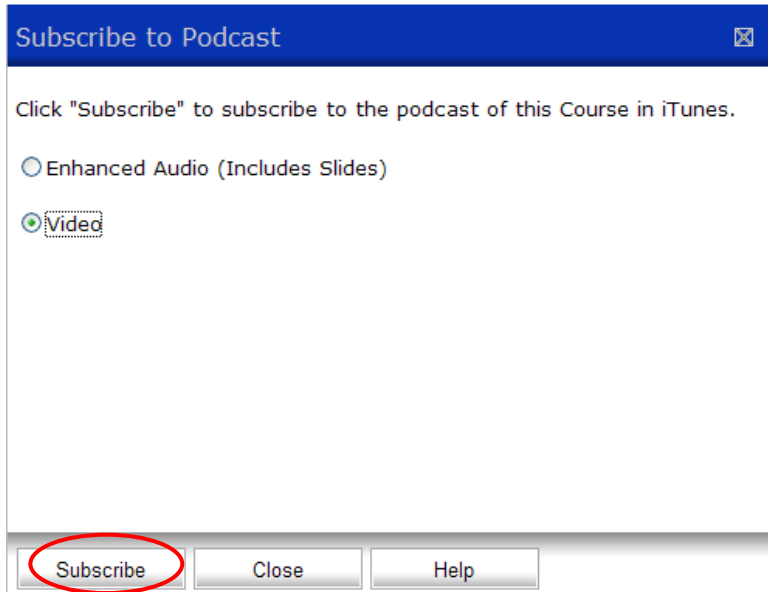


Figure 7: Subscribe to Vodcast Dialog Box

4. Click **Subscribe**. iTunes opens and displays the podcast.


