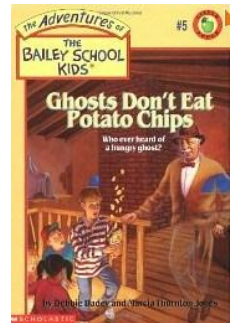
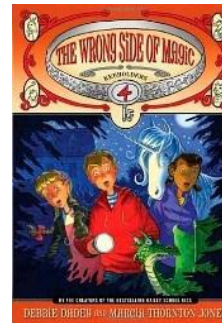
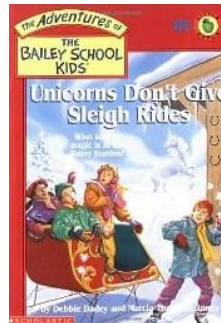
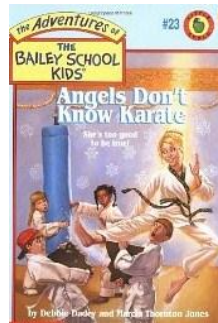
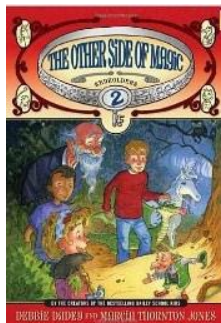
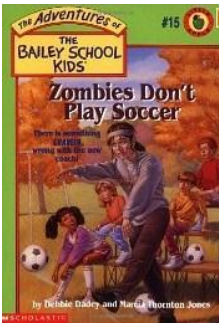




The *WKU Kentucky Reading Project and Writing Project and WKRC* present the 4th annual *Breakfast with an Author...*
