This order holds regardless of function of pronoun. Thus *te* precedes *le* and *lui* whether *te* is pronominal, direct or indirect. This order holds for all statements whether affirmative or negative, declarative or interrogative, indicative or imperative--**with the exception of an affirmative command (imperative)**.
