Admission Requirements for Master of Music Degree in Music Education-Teacher Leader

- 1. A baccalaureate degree in music from a NASM-accredited institution with a GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- 2. A completed application to the WKU Music Department
- 3. A completed application to the WKU Graduate School
- 4. Pre-screen audition materials submitted to <u>Dr. Catherine Wilson</u> via email before **December 1**:
 - a. A formal letter of intent to audition into the WKU Master of Music Program.
 - b. A current curriculum vitae.
 - c. Link to a 10–15-minute performance of 2-3 solo repertoire selections on your major instrument featuring a variety of styles and languages (vocal only).
 - d. Link to a current (within the last two years) classroom or lesson teaching video.
 - e. A valid teaching certificate or Statement of Eligibility for P-12 Music Certification (Integrated, Vocal, or Instrumental).
 - f. An academic writing sample that demonstrates style and ability of approximately five pages in length, double-spaced. An academic paper from the undergraduate degree is acceptable. Any writing samples found to have been written with AI will be rejected.
- 5. Based on application materials, selected applicants will be asked for an additional online or on-campus interview in **February** or **March**.
