

Transfer Plan for KCTCS to WKU:

HEALTH SCIENCES, B.S.

Purpose: To promote transfer of credits from the A.A.S. degree in Occupational Therapy from any KCTCS institution into the B.S. in Health Sciences at WKU.

Admissions Process:

- Applicants for the Western Kentucky University's Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences require the following criteria:
- 1. Students must complete an AAS in Occupational Therapy at KCTCS to be eligible to participate in this transfer agreement. If the student goes on to complete the AA or AS after the AAS in Occupational Therapy from KCTCS, this plan for a BS in Health Sciences can be utilized.
- 2. Admission to WKU.
- Program Delivery Methods: This program is designed as a distance program, and thus students do not need to relocate to the WKU campus in Bowling Green (although they may do so if desired), see: <u>http://www.wku.edu/online/courses.html</u>

Application of Credits:

- 1. This agreement permits KCTCS graduates to transfer an AAS in Occupational Therapy from KCTCS.
- Transfer students in the Health Science program must complete WKU's General Education requirements and comply with all published Academic Requirements and Regulations (see WKU Catalog for details). Additional general education coursework needed to fulfill a WKU BS degree program may be taken through WKU or KCTCS.
- 3. While working on the AAS at KCTCS, students are encouraged to complete the following course as a foundation for the BS in Health Sciences: PHY 231 (General University Physics, NS), COM 181 (Basic Public Speaking, OC).
- 4. The table below outlines the requirements for a BS in Health Sciences, once the AAS is completed. Two options are outlined: 1) transfer to WKU for remaining requirements, or 2) to continue at KCTCS until General Education courses are completed. There is a <u>third</u> option for the student that completes the AA or AS in addition to the AAS in Occupational Therapy. In this third option, no additional General Education courses are necessary and the student only needs to complete 30 hours at WKU courses (the Health Sciences courses listed below, and 7 hours of open electives). A total of 120 credit hours are required for a WKU B.S. degree.
