We did modify our intructional methodology beginning fall 2021 to prepare our spring 2023 class for the new Next Generation (NGN) NCLEX-RN. This updated exam is designed to test for clinical judgement which employers have noted as a weakness in new nurse graduates. Students have been taught this way of thinking through unfolding case studies in the classroom and they have tested their clinical judgement skills by taking HESI nationally normed exams. In addition, ShadowHealth, a new technology using virtual patients was adopted in fall 2022. ShadowHealth offers real-life simulations where the student practices communicating with patients, assessing the patient, and delivering the appropriate nursing care. Fall 2022 the program adopted the Elsevier 360 Package which contains the following resources: Sherpath, online courses, Elsevier adaptive quizzing next generation book specific, eBooks, clinical skills RN collection, HESI case studies/patient review/practice test, SimChart with clinical key, ShadowHealth digital clinical experiences, simulation learning suite, HESI readiness dashboard for NCLEX, HESI next generation specialty/custom exams, HESI next generation exit exams, HESI comprehensive review for the NCLEX ebook, Elsevier adaptive quizzing next generation for NCLEX, and HESI compass personal assessment builder. In addition, we started a mentoring program for pre-nursing and admitted nursing students staffed by faculty after hours weekly.

The pilot of the NGN NCLEX-style questions in ExamSoft testing software did not go well. After we purchased the contract and reviewed the questions, there were very few questions in the exam bank that we could use in our courses. We decided not to renew this contract for AY 23-24.

Faculty believe these subscores may not reflect the true ability of our students. Students have reported that they rush through the exam to get finished quickly by just clicking on any answer. The course points associated with this exam are approximately 10% of the total course points, therefore, a poor score on this exam does not impact the course grade.

<u>Results</u>: The pass rate of our graduates has slowly declined since 2020, however, we were not anticipating to drop below 90%. However, we are higher than the National pass rate percentage. Scores have very likely been affected by under-prepared students due to the pandemic.

Conclusions: We have not made any major changes to admission criteria, course content, course sequence, advisement. textbooks, facilities, or faculty.

We did modify our intructional methodology beginning fall 2021 to prepare our spring 2023 class for the new Next Generation (NGN) NCLEX-RN. This updated exam is designed to test for clinical judgement which employers have noted as a weakness in new nurse graduates. Students have been taught this way of thinking through unfolding case studies in the classroom and they have tested their clinical judgement skills by taking HESI nationally normed exams. In addition, ShadowHealth, a new technology using virtual patients was adopted in fall 2022. ShadowHealth offers real-life simulations where the student practices communicating with patients, assessing the patient, and delivering the appropriate nursing care. Fall 2022 the program adopted the Elsevier 360 Package which contains the following resources: Sherpath, online courses, Elsevier adaptive quizzing next generation book specific, eBooks, clinical skills RN collection, HESI case studies/patient review/practice test, SimChart with clinical key, ShadowHealth digital clinical experiences, simulation learning suite, HESI readiness dashboard for NCLEX, HESI next generation specialty/custom exams, HESI next generation exit exams, HESI comprehensive review for the NCLEX ebook, Elsevier adaptive quizzing next generation for NCLEX, and HESI compass personal assessment builder. In addition, we started a mentoring program for pre-nursing and admitted nursing students staffed by faculty after hours weekly.

The pilot of the NGN NCLEX-style questions in ExamSoft testing software did not go well. After we purchased the contract and reviewed the questions, there were very few questions in the exam bank that we could use in our courses. We decided not to renew this contract for AY 23-24.

<u>Plans for Next Assessment Cycle</u>: We plan to continue using HESI 360, and include the 3-day face to face exam review during finals week which is included in the package. We will continue using the mentoring sessions to enhance student learning. In addition, we will review admission criteria.
