

## RESEARCH CONTRACT

Date RESEARCH CONTRACT
The Gatton Academy encourages students to participate in mentored research projects. For the sake of richer projects and greater understanding of the research work, completion of two full semesters of research or more is promoted. Likewise, students are encouraged to use their research to produce academic outcomes as possible, such as conference presentations, entry to scientific competitions, and even publication. At the onset of each semester of the experience, students are required to have this Research Contract signed by the WKU faculty member who has agreed to mentor their project.
Research Mentor: Thank you for providing a Gatton Academy student mentorship to perform research under your supervision. By signing below, you agree to oversee a research project for the semester (credit-offering or not at your discretion—see below) for an Academy student.
Research Supplies Grants are available for WKU faculty who mentor a Gatton Academy student. This \$250/per academic year for each Academy student you work with can be used to purchase research equipment or software to benefit your work with an Academy student. Research Supplies Grants funds are limited; application cycles start each July 1 until funds are exhausted. Likewise, if Academy students have the opportunity to travel for conference presentations, we can also assist with their expenses through a limited funding resource. <u>Credit</u> : Academy students can earn credit hours for research projects that begin before the drop/add date of each new semester. Credit can be earned at 1, 2, or 3 hours per semester at your recommendation. It's likely your department offers a section for independent research, but if not, Academy students can be registered in an HON 303: Independent Research section if the appropriate paperwork is into the Honors College by the semester drop/add date.
