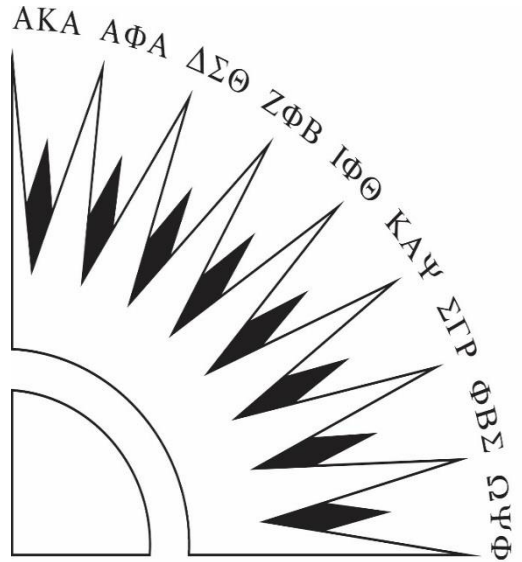

# OUTSTANDING BLACK STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS



## REQUIREMENTS:

- African American student
- 2.75 cumulative GPA
- Spring 2018, full-time enrollment
- Open to all students, regardless of NPHC affiliation (**Previous scholarship recipients are ineligible**)
- 20 documented community service hours in the last year (Fall 2016-Fall 2017)
- 2 letters of recommendation (with at least one from a university staff/faculty member)
- Resume included with application
- Essays (of no more than 500 words each) answering the following prompts:
  - Why do you feel you are deserving of a NPHC Outstanding Black Student scholarship?
  - Explain the importance of education for the African American community.

## DATES TO REMEMBER:

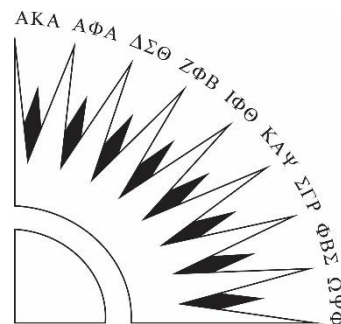
- December 1, 2017 - Deadline for the application
