Courses that will assist in DAT preparation and your first 2 years in dental school include: Animal Biology, Animal Physiology, Cell/Molecular Biology, Genetics, Cell Biology, Histology, Comparative Anatomy, and Immunology.

The Bachelor's Degree requires 120 hours. The major + minor must total at least 54 hours (48 unduplicated). A student may opt for a 48 major with no minor.

* "Pre-Dent" is not a major, but is a concentration.

APPLICATION TIMETABLE

Study for the DAT	Now! At least 6 months prior to attempting the test. Preparation is essential.
Register for the DAT	Register early (60-90 days prior) for the date and location you desire (seats are limited). Cost, \$415.
DAT	May, June or July, 1 year prior to matriculation in dental school.
AADSAS Online App.	Primary application to dental school, you may begin working on it in June, and should be submitted July 1 st or shortly thereafter. Cost, \$245 + \$93/school.
Pre-Dental Eval Committee	After you complete your application, contact your advisor.
Secondary Applications	Submit as soon as you can adequately complete.
Interviews	As early as late August, as late as March or April.
Acceptances	As early as December 1st and as late as the day before classes begin.

- Your DAT scores are printed out for you at the Thompson Prometric Test Center before you leave.
- Scholarships and other forms of Financial Aid are available, most students take out loans
