The Bachelor's Degree requires 120 hours. The major + minor must total at least 54 hours (48 unduplicated). A student may opt for a 48 major with no minor.

* "Pre-opt" is not a major, but is a concentration.

Now! At least 6 months prior to attempting the test. Preparation is essential. Register early (60-90 days prior) for the date and location you desire (seats are limited). **Cost, \$330.**

May - August, 1 year prior to matriculation in optometry school. Primary application to opt school, you may begin working on it in June, and should be submitted July 15th or shortly thereafter. **Cost, \$160 + \$60/school.**

After you complete your application, contact your advisor.

Submit as soon as you can adequately complete.

As early as late August, as late as March or April.

As early as September 1st and as late as the day before classes begin.
