The 2012-2013 AOL report to the college was passed out for members to review. No changes were made

An updated undergraduate schedule of AOL activities was handed out. The new schedule only includes 5 goals and reflects the new goal three; Strategic and Critical thinking.

The senior exit exam has been updated and deployed to those courses that have requested it. Members were asked to consult with their departments for changes for the spring 2014 version. Questions that students have scored high on should be considered for replacement with questions that examines discipline knowledge that has not been tested.

Fall 2013 AOL Undergraduate Action Plan

1. Collect and evaluate data for Goal 1: (Communication)
2. Collect and evaluate data on Goal 3: (Strategic and Critical Thinking)
3. Collect data and evaluate data for 5: (Discipline Knowledge)

Grading rubrics for these activities were reviewed for appropriateness and no changes were made.

Fall AOL Graduate Action Plan

1. Collect and evaluate indirect measures on Goal 1: (Communication)
2. Continue collecting data on Goal 1: (Teamwork)
3. Collect data on Goal 3: Critical Thinking / Decision Making)
4. Collect data in the PMBA program on Global Awareness

The same rubrics used to evaluate undergraduate students will be used for the graduate students for goals 1 & 3. The expectation is that graduate students would achieve a 3.5 or higher on each goal.

The grading rubric for the PMBA Global Awareness goal was reviewed. The category labels will be changed to Admirable, Acceptable, and Amateur to reflect the same names used in the other rubrics.
