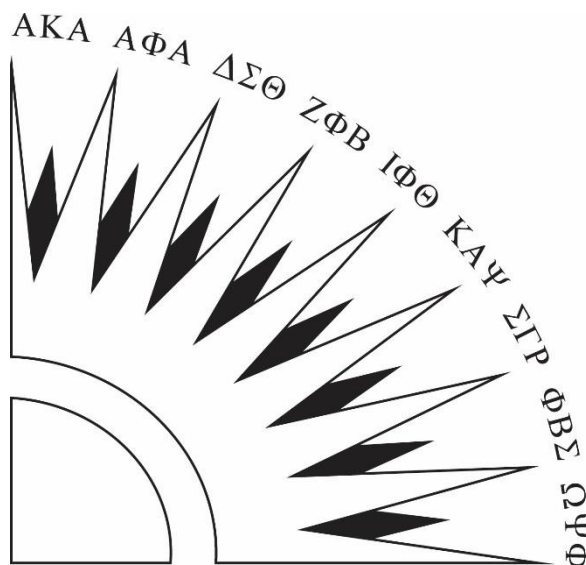

REQUIREMENTS:

- African American student.
- 2.75 cumulative GPA.
- Spring 2017, full-time enrollment.
- Open to all students, regardless of NPHC affiliation
- 20 documented community service hours in the last year (Fall 2015-Fall 2016).
- 2 letters of recommendation (with at least one from a university staff/faculty member).
- Resume and personal statement included with application.
- Essays (of no more than 500 words each) answering the following prompts:
 - Why do you feel you are deserving of a NPHC Outstanding Black Student scholarship?
 - Explain the importance of education for the African American community.

DATES TO REMEMBER:

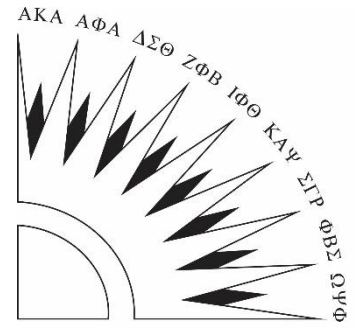
- October 14 by 4:30 p.m., applications are due to Student Activities (DSU 2059) in a sealed envelope.
