## **EdD Program Research Assistant Positions**

The Educational Leadership doctoral program at WKU has received a grant to evaluate the Green River Regional Education Cooperative's (GRREC) Race to the Top-District (RTT-D) program, kid-FRIENDLy (Kids Focused, Responsible, Imaginative, Engaged, and Determined to Learn) Learning, awarded by the U.S. Department of Education. The Rock Solid Evaluation team is seeking **multiple research assistants** to carry out three types of evaluation: a *formative* review related both to the intended outcomes and the implementation itself, a *summative* evaluation of the outcomes, and a separate *implementation* evaluation to determine the level of fidelity needed to achieve noted gains.

## **Essential duties and responsibilities**

- Assist with planning and implementing evaluation activities
- Develop data collection instruments, such as surveys, classroom observation protocols, and other tools to collect timely data
- Coordinate with districts and schools and make site visits to collect data
- Manage and analyze evaluation data using computer packages
- Conduct literature reviews and assist with evaluation reports

Two broad types of skill sets are needed: (a) experience/familiarity with P-12 school settings, (b) knowledge/experience in data management and statistical analysis. All graduate assistants will gain experience and expertise in both areas under the guidance of the Rock Solid evaluation team.

## Applicants should possess some or all of the following qualifications:

- Knowledge of educational systems in the US. A previous background in P-12 school settings is desired.
- Ability to travel to school sites in GRREC and/or OVEC
- Strong research skills, including familiarity with Excel, SPSS, and/or other statistical software; and/or with qualitative data analysis software
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
- Ability to work independently and as a team member
- Responsible, reliable, and detail-oriented

## **Position details**

- 20 hours per week during fall, spring, and summer semesters
- 12-month Graduate Assistant salaries
- EdD program tuition & doctoral fee waivers
- Positions to begin in Fall 2013, with possible multi-year renewals
