ANTHOLOGY PORTFOLIO EXPLAINED

- University-wide adoption starting fall 2022
- Platform used to store and share information
 - Annual Activity Reports; Continuance documents; Tenure and/or Promotion Portfolios
 - Formally called Chalk and Wire
- Benefits
 - **Simplify** processes (e.g. sharing and accessing annual activity, continuance, and T&P)
 - Reduce redundancies
 - Minimize duplication
 - Streamline sharing of information
 - **Repository** for documents and approvals

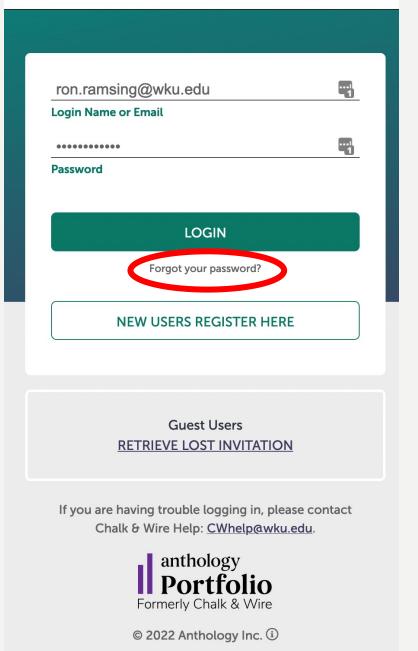
TIPS

- Read instructions for each section before uploading (e.g. upload date on CV)
- Upload merged documents (one file) for continuance and T&P
- Preview the upload(s)
- Provide feedback (suggestions, recommendations, concerns, etc.)
