

Effective Monday, June 14, 2021

The wearing of a face mask will be required for all UNVACCINATED individuals.

Unvaccinated individuals should maintain a minimum of 6 feet physical distance from others while in the facility.

It is of the utmost importance that unvaccinated individuals place the safety of our staff, of our patrons, and our guests with the highest regard. The Preston Center has been a safe haven for everyone throughout the pandemic and we are hopeful that all unvaccinated individuals will follow this state and university policy. Failure to do so could cause a COVID outbreak that would trace back to the Preston Center. If this occurs the Preston Center may have to revert to the COVID-19 policies followed during the height of the pandemic.

All children under 12 years of age will still be required to wear masks.

We hope that all unvaccinated individuals are honest and considerate of others when using the Preston Center.

In addition to no longer requiring masks for those who are fully vaccinated beginning June 14th, the following restrictions will also be lifted at the Preston Center:

- We will no longer restrict access to the facility based on capacity limits.
- While we will maintain an enhanced cleaning and sanitation schedule, we still encourage all members to assist us in wiping down all equipment before and after usage.
- There will no longer be a space capacity limit or restrictions on the gymnasium (hardwood and blue courts), racquetball courts, dance studio, and multipurpose room.
- Daily locker check out will be available for all lockers outside of the locker room.
- Equipment check out for court use and fitness center use will be available.
- Towel service at the front desk and fitness center will be available.

- Stay home when you are sick
- Get tested immediately, with your health care provider, when sick
