In order to register for CNS 591, a B must be earned in the following 5 courses: CNS 554; CNS 555; CNS 558; CNS 559; CNS 560. Intensive Weekends are scheduled during CNS 559 (First weekend in November) and 554 Course (First Weekend April).
