Please consult with an academic advisor at WKU for the Health Sciences program regarding this concentration.

SAMPLE – Academic Plan

First Year

Complete appropriate first-year courses to apply toward associate degree in a focused health are.

Transfer students with an acceptable associate degree in a focused health are who wish to earn the Health Science degree must comply with all published Academic Requirements and Regulations (see WKU Catalog for details). Additional general education/colonnade coursework needed to become fully-certified in General Education may be taken through WKU or KCTCS.

WKU Associate-Degreed students must meet all published Academic Requirements and Regulations, including WKU Colonnade/General Education, major, and degree requirements (see WKU Catalog for details).

Second Year

Complete appropriate second-year courses to earn associate degree in a focused helath area. While working on the Health related Associate degree at KCTCS or WKU, students are encouraged to complete the following courses in the first/second years as a foundation for the BS in Health Sciences. WKU Associate Degree seeking students are also encouraged to complete ENG 100 (FW-1) and Arts & Humanities (E-AH) in the first two years.
