**Deadline: October 1, 2018**

- Eligibility:** All undergraduate English majors and minors (any concentration) and all other undergraduate students currently enrolled in a creative writing class.
- Guidelines:** Each student may submit one poem. The entry itself should not include the author's name but should be accompanied by a cover sheet with the author's name, address, email address, and phone number. Submissions should be turned in at the English Department office (CH 135). Finalists will be chosen by a judging panel; winners will be selected by the workshop host. Submissions will not be returned.
- Workshop:** The authors of the top ten poems will participate in a workshop, conducted by Cheryl Hopson, on October 28, from 10:00 a.m. until 12:00.
- Recognition:** The ten finalists will be recognized later that day at the Mary Ellen and Jim Wayne Miller Celebration of Writing—2:00 p.m., in the Kentucky Building. At that time, first, second, and third place winners will also be announced.
