**Workshop:** The authors of the top ten poems will participate in a workshop, conducted by Cheryl Hopson, on October

28, from 10:00 a.m. until 12:00.

**Recognition:** The ten finalists will be recognized later that day at the Mary Ellen and Jim Wayne Miller Celebration of

Writing — 2:00 p.m., in the Kentucky Building. At that time, first, second, and third place winners will also be

announced.
