Hope Harbor's mission is to empower and support anyone impacted by sexual trauma. We are committed to our community to affect social change to eliminate all forms of sexual violence, advocate for the rights of survivors of sexual assault and abuse, and provide specialized treatment interventions.

Hope Harbor is a non-profit crisis counseling center that provides one-of-a-kind services to victims of sexual assault and their families and friends. These services are available to residents in Allen, Barren, Butler, Edmonson, Hart, Logan, Metcalfe, Monroe, Simpson, and Warren Counties in Kentucky. The main office is in Bowling Green with satellite offices for additional counseling services located in Glasgow and Russellville.

All Hope Harbor services are FREE and CONFIDENTIAL to all individuals impacted by sexual violence regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity, race, religion or cultural identity. If you have been impacted by sexual violence, WE WANT TO HELP!

This toll-free number is available to victims of recent or past abuse and their friends and family members. Callers may talk about issues related to sexual assault confidentially.

- [Emergency Advocacy](#)

An on-call advocate quickly responds to a hospital or legal law enforcement agency, providing important information and critical support to a victim during a medical examination and/or legal interview. This service is available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week.

- [Counseling](#)

With the help of counseling, a victim has the opportunity to become a survivor. Counseling sessions are strictly confidential and tailored to each individual. Family members and significant others are also invited to receive counseling in an effort to support the victim. Individual, family, and group counseling is available.

📄 Education and Prevention

Programs are available for schools, churches, businesses, civic organizations, and others. Programs are appropriate for pre-school age and up. Topics include: body safety, self-esteem, sexual harassment, [dating](#) violence, rape awareness, risk reduction, internet safety, and recognizing [child](#) sexual abuse for parents and teachers.

📄 Legal Advocacy

At the request of the victim, a Hope Harbor's legal advocate provides information about the legal system, and may accompany the victim to the trial and/or any legal meeting with law enforcement officials, attorneys, etc
