

COVID-19 Response

Campus Wide COVID Restock

The second week of January, ESA's were busy restocking their area's with COVID-19 supplies. Although ESA's checked the supply levels throughout the fall semester, DFM determined it would be beneficial to completely resupply certain items.

Restock boxes were prepared for every building on campus. ESA supervisors picked up the box from the stockroom and distributed supplies to the centralized offices within each building.

Every office on campus received *at least* 1 16oz bottle of hand sanitizer. All departments/offices also received a bottle of glasses defogging spray, a microfiber cloth and instruction guide. Additional paper towels, bottles of disinfectant solution, disposable masks, and gloves were distributed based on need. These items helped ease anxiety among faculty and staff members returning to campus.

- Roughly 200 bottles of hand sanitizer were issued.
- 176 bottles of lense spray and microfiber cloths were distributed to offices across campus.
- 36 bottles of disinfectant spray were allocated for the labs in Ogden Hall .
