

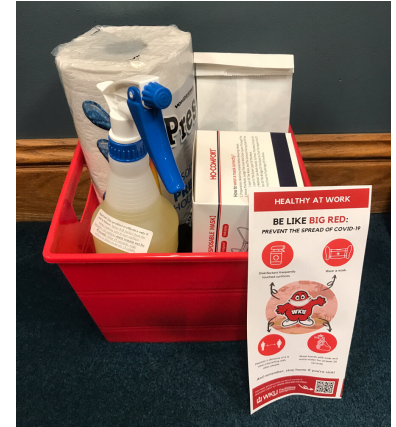
COVID-19 Response

Developing and Distributing Disinfectant Kits

DFM has been an essential player in executing the university response to COVID-19. Since current ESA staff must focus energy on cleaning public spaces, it was essential to develop a plan to provide cleaning supplies directly to faculty/staff. Facilities Management, Supply Chain Management and Environmental Health and Safety have been busy developing a plan to get safety supplies to offices across campus. The first group of items given to faculty and staff was an office disinfectant kit. These disinfectant kits will allow faculty and staff to disinfect their offices as-needed in between routine cleanings.

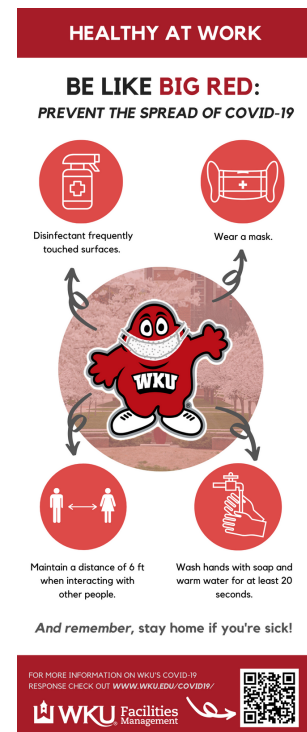
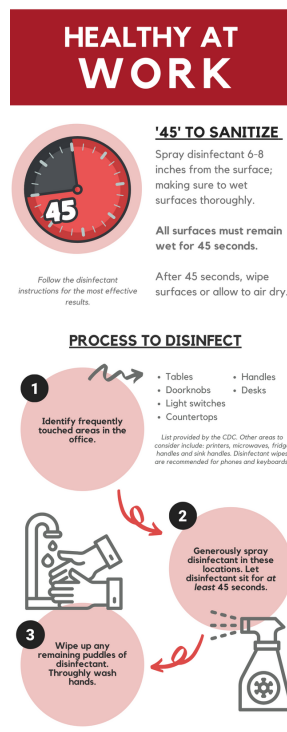
In July, DFM will coordinate the delivery of bulk hand-sanitizer stations to each building on campus. These dispensers will be located at the entrance to each building.

In June, DFM responded to 47 staff requests for disinfectant kits.



Each kit includes...

- 24oz Bottle of Disinfectant
- Roll of Paper Towels
- 16oz Bottle of Hand Sanitizer
- 10 Disposable Masks
- 5 Pairs of Gloves
- 2 Reusable Masks
- Infoguide
- Storage Container
