COMPLETE THE FAFSA APPLICATION

- In order to apply for federal aid, you must register for an FSA ID at www.studentaid.gov

FAFSA opens on October 1st!

CHECK VERIFICATION STATUS

- Students will be notified by KHEAA if been randomly selected by the Dept. of Ed. WKU cannot award financial aid until verification has been completed. Visit kheaavverify.com to get all the necessary steps to complete verification.

To check for missing documents, students can log into TopNet, click on the Financial Aid tab, then click on [Financial Aid Eligibility](#) and/or [Financial Aid Status](#).

GET YOUR WKU AID OFFER

- A second email will be sent regarding your estimated aid offer, and will eventually be followed by your official aid offer sent to you in the mail.

ACCEPT/DECLINE AID OFFER

- In order to view, accept, or decline your financial aid, after receiving your official aid offer, you must log in to your TopNet account; select the [Financial Aid](#) tab, choose [Award](#), and select the appropriate aid year from the drop-down menu. Certain trust fund scholarships must be accepted in Top-Dollar.

Priority Scholarship Acceptance Deadline for 23/24 is September 1st, 2023

BORROWING FEDERAL LOANS?

- If you have accepted your federal student loans, and are a first-time borrower, you must visit studentaid.gov and complete your Entrance Counseling and e-sign your Master Promissory Note. Your loans will not disburse until these two steps have been completed.

CHECK YOUR WKU BILLING ACCOUNT
