
WKU Fly Fishing Montana

Sept 14-19: WKU Students & Community

Sept 20-25: Community (non-students). *This trip has a current maximum of 11 participants*]

Experience level: No prior fly-fishing experience is required. This program is designed to meet the needs of the complete beginner and 'experts' alike; whatever an expert is. All fishing will be from drift boats or rafts. Being able to cast a flyrod is certainly helpful, but not a requirement as on-the-river instruction is readily available. WKU has successfully offered this program since 2012 to participants with a wide range of abilities (from no prior experience to being a fly-fishing guide).

Program description introduction: Join WKU and experience fly fishing on world-renowned waters which contain several trout species and other fish such as mountain whitefish, northern pikeminnow, and pike. Guides typically take participants on one or more of the following rivers: Blackfoot, Clark Fork, Bitterroot.



What does the program include?

- 4 days of guided fly fishing and instruction (float trips with one guide and 2 anglers per boat)
- Use of fly-fishing equipment (rod, reel, etc.)
- Terminal tackle (*leader*, *tippet*, *flies*)
- Guide gratuity (participants can tip additionally if desired)
- 5 nights lodging at the Holiday Inn Downtown Missoula (*double occupancy*).
- Lunch on the river (on the four fishing days).
- Missoula airport hotel shuttle.

Not included:

- Transportation to/from Missoula, MT not included in program cost.
- Travel cancellation/interruption insurance. Highly recommended.
- Montana fishing license + associated fees (conservation and aquatic invasion species)
- Meals other than lunches on the four fishing days.

- WKU Student Pricing: \$2,750 = 9 participants, \$2,650 = 11 participants
