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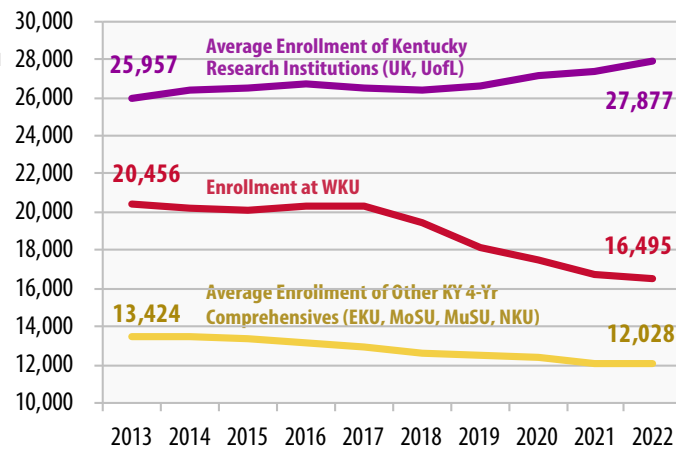


STUDENT ENROLLMENT TRENDS

at a glance...

Average enrollment at Kentucky's four-year comprehensive institutions, including at WKU, has declined since 2013. Enrollment at Kentucky's research institutions, on the other hand, has increased since 2013.

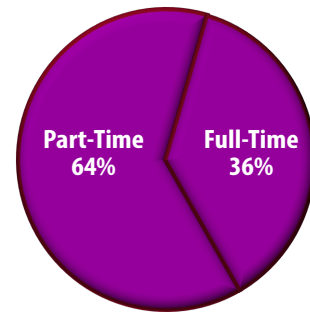

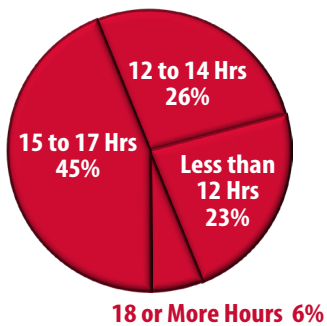

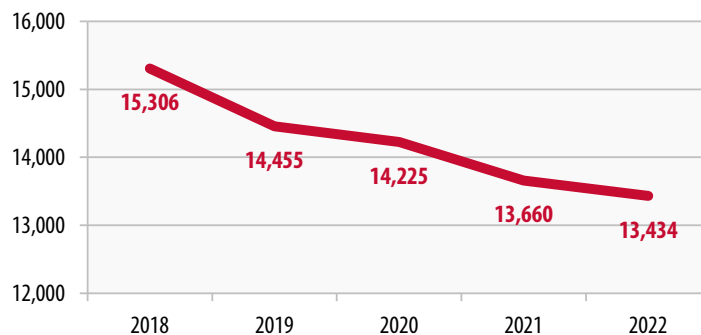

Full-Time Equivalent Enrollment (1/3 Method)¹

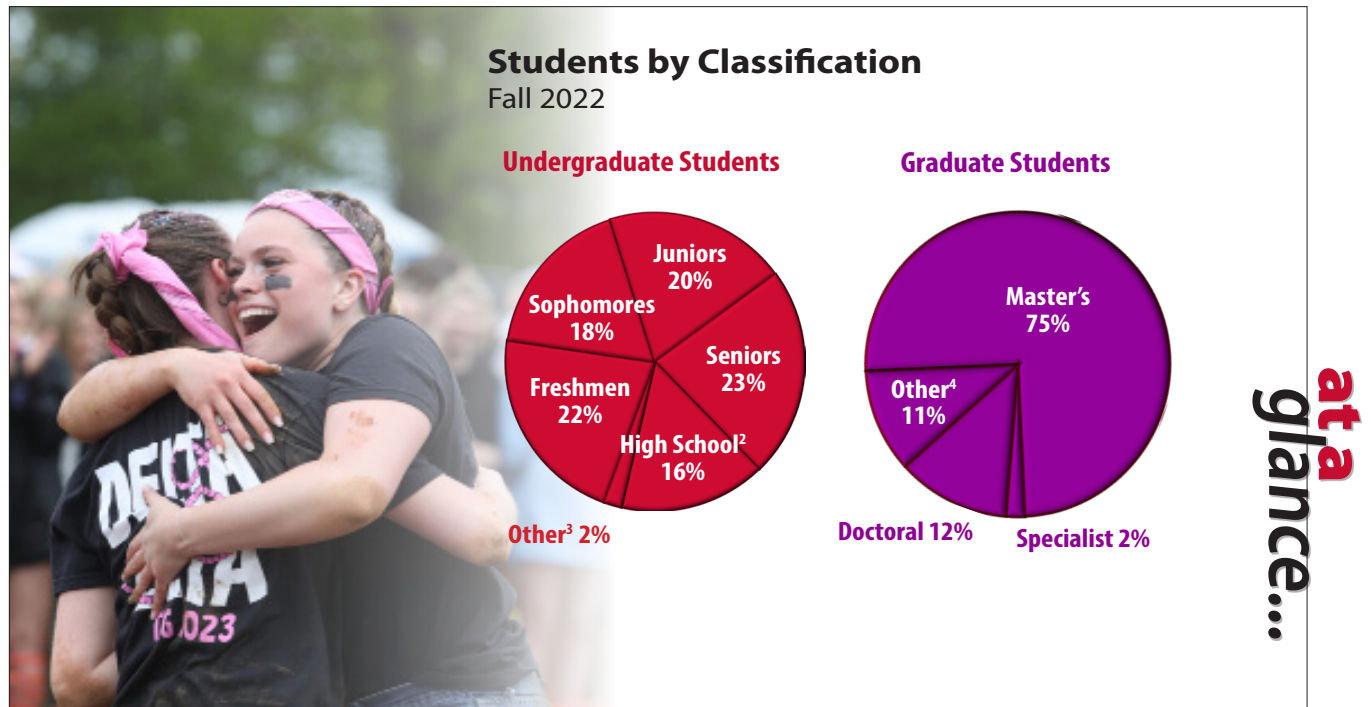

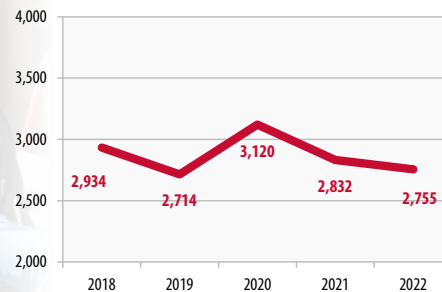

Fall 2018-Fall 2022



First-time first-year enrollment decreased by 9% between Fall 2020 and Fall 2021 and by 3% between Fall 2021 and Fall 2022. These decreases followed a 15% increase in first-time first-year enrollment between Fall 2019 and Fall 2020.

- Usher's "Yeah," featuring Lil Jon and Ludacris, topped the Billboard Hot 100. Usher also took the #2 spot with "Burn."

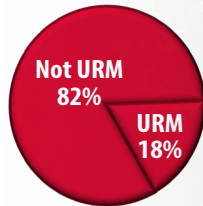


STUDENTS BY ETHNICITY

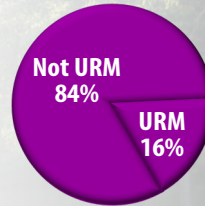

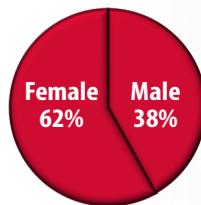

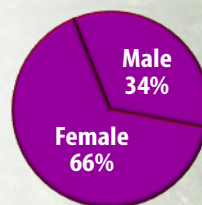

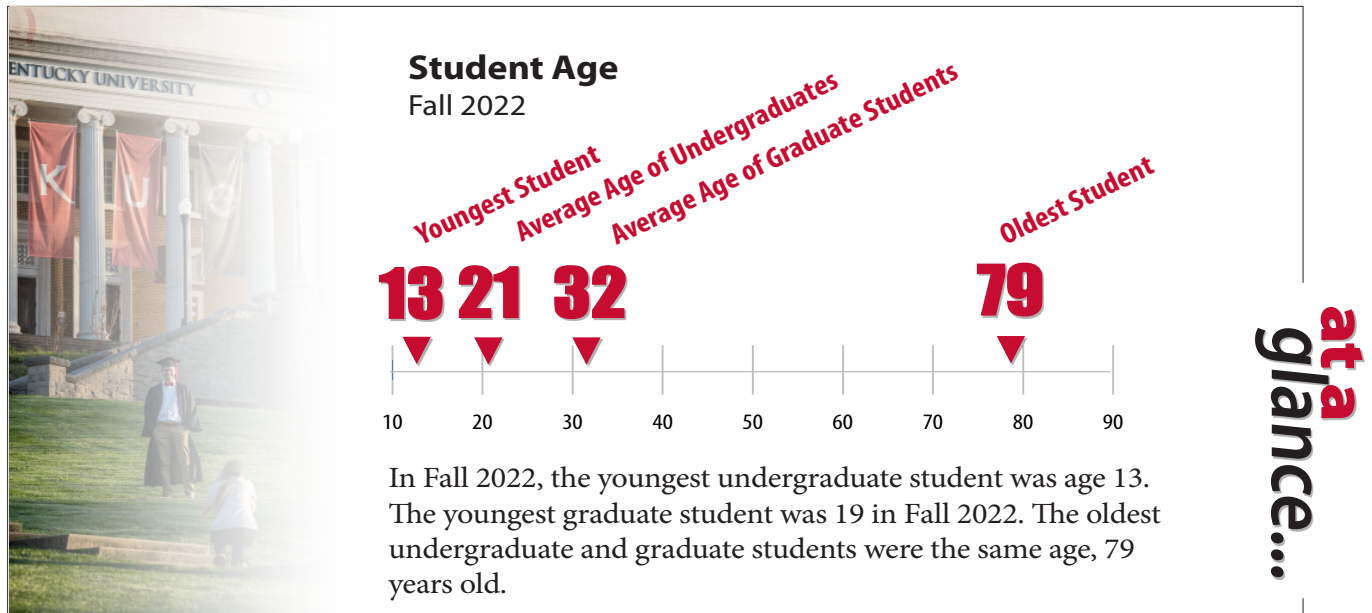

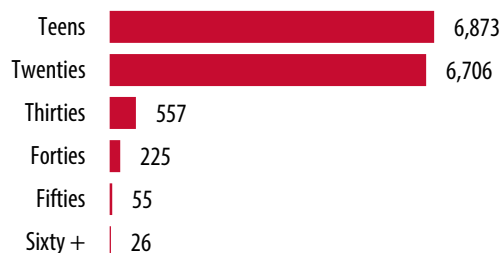


STUDENTS BY AGE

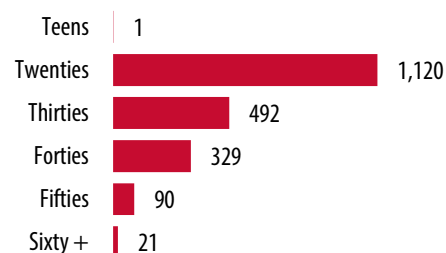

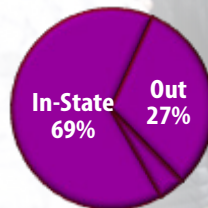

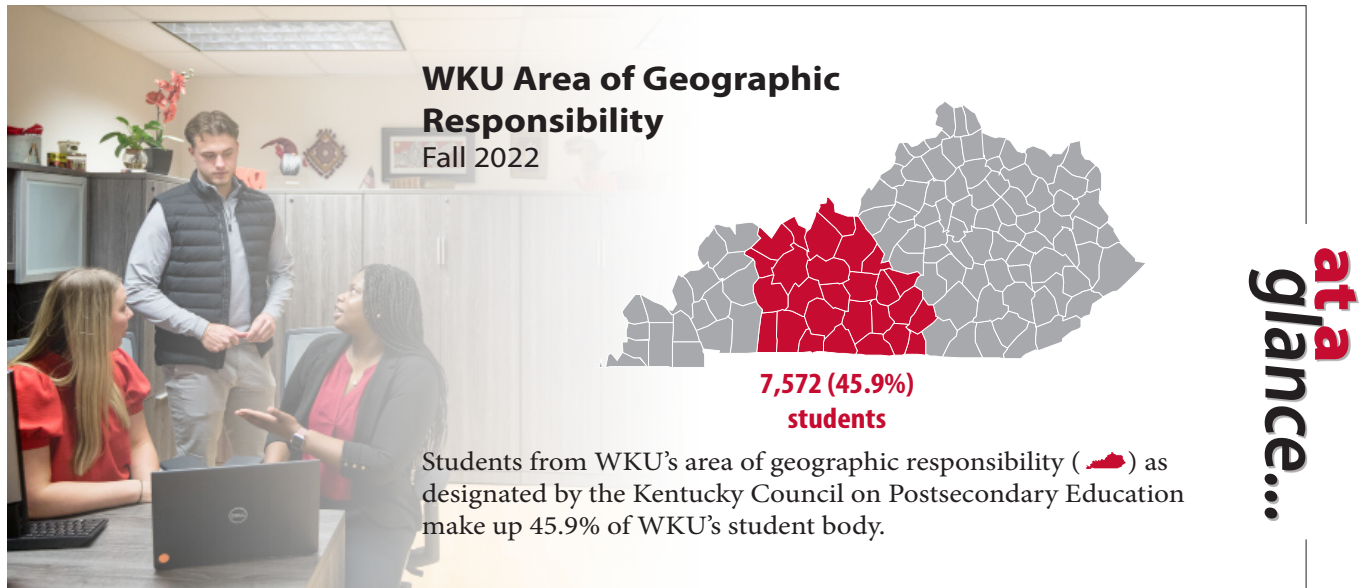

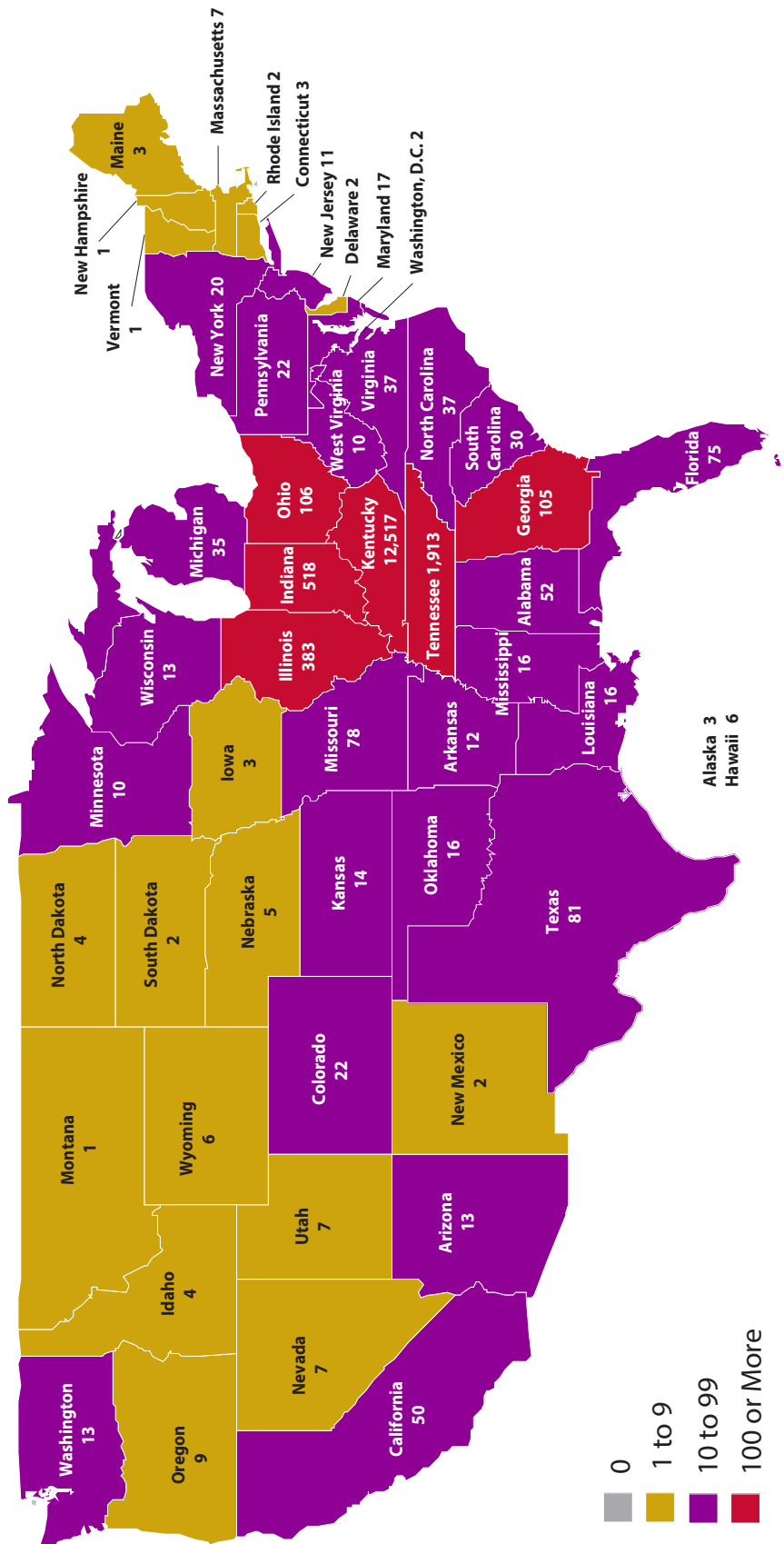

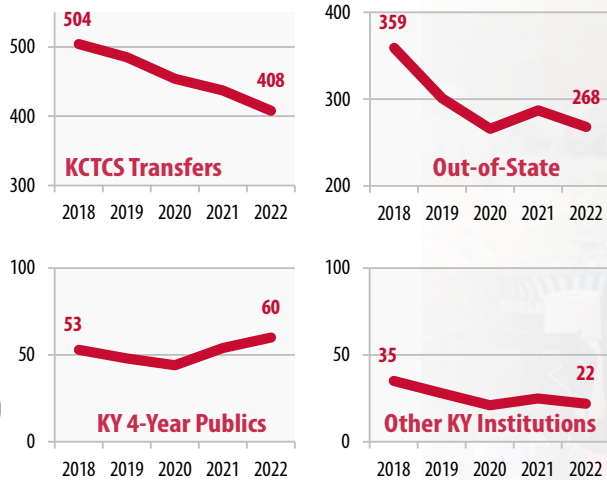

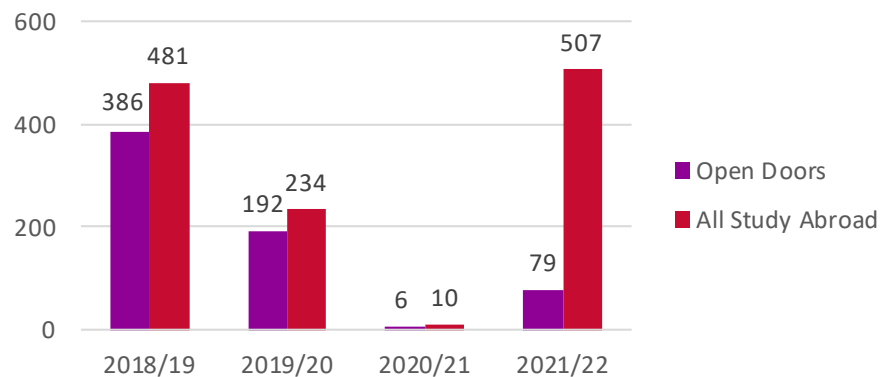

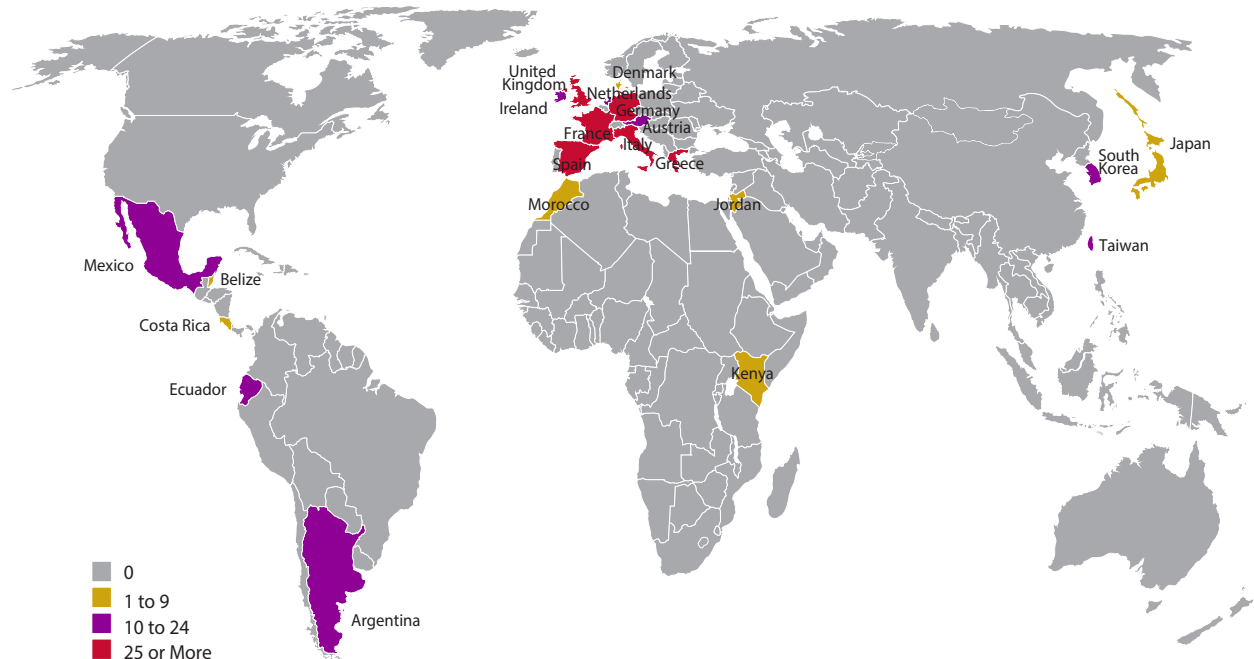

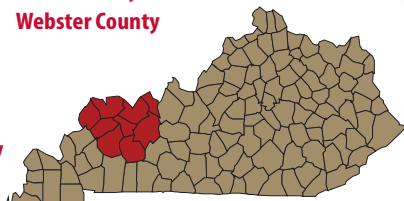

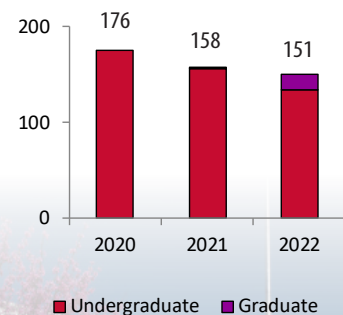

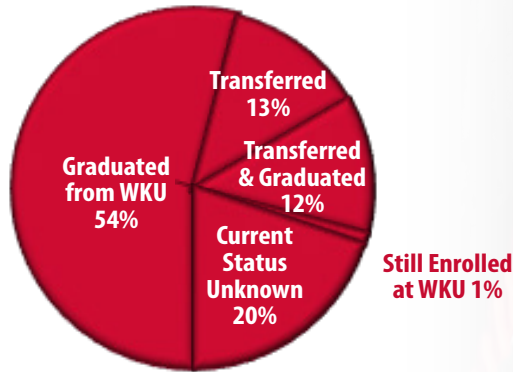

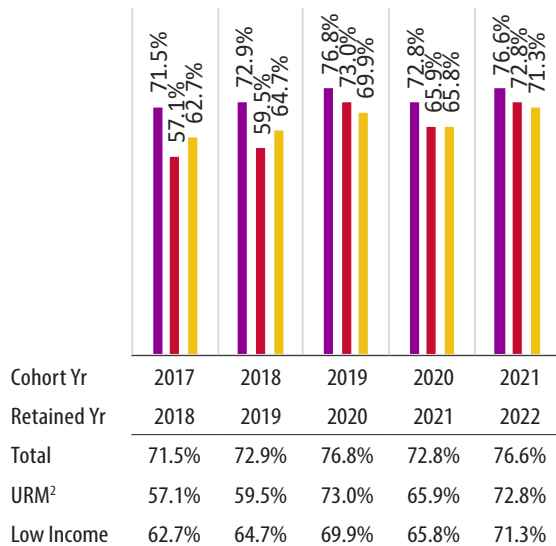

2016 Cohort

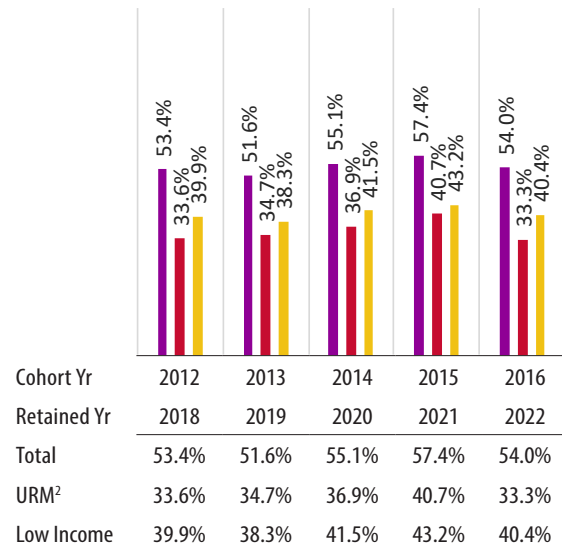


Fifty-four percent of full-time first-year baccalaureate degree-seeking students in the 2016 cohort graduated from WKU within six years. Twenty-five percent transferred to another institution, and 49% of those graduated within six years. Another 1% were still enrolled at the university after six years, with the current status of the remaining 20% unknown.
