



CREDIT HOURS & FULL-TIME EQUIVALENCY














Students by Level and Age







WKU in Somerset was created in 2019 when WKU became a founding partner of the University Center of Southern Kentucky at Somerset Community College. In Fall 2022, WKU added a 2+2 Elementary Education degree in Somerset, allowing students to complete an associate degree from Somerset Community College and a bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from WKU.

In 2024, the program celebrated its inaugural graduates with two students completing their bachelor's degrees in Elementary Education. In Fall 2024, 26 undergraduate students were enrolled at WKU in Somerset.








