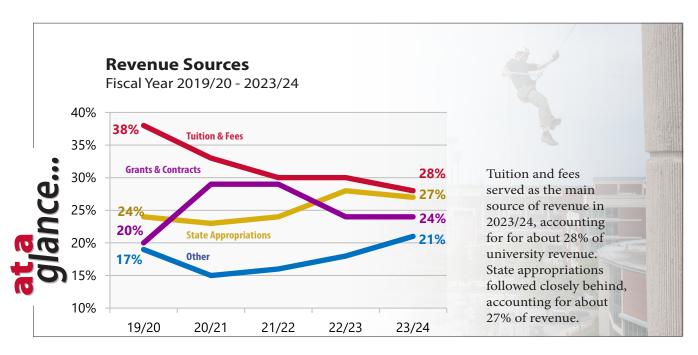




REVENUE & EXPENDITURES



WKU Revenue & Expenditures 2023/24



Revenue from tuition and fees decreased by about \$2.6 million, or about 2.8%, between 2022/23 and 2023/24.

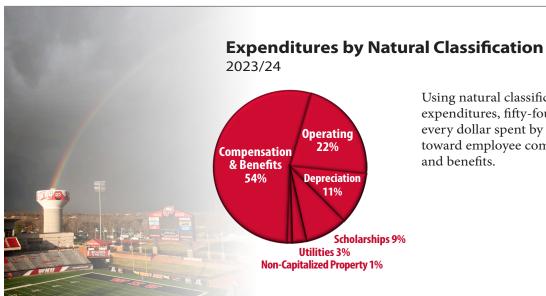
In 2022/23, revenue from tuition and fees was \$91.7 million compared to \$89.1 in 2023/24.

Revenue from state appropriations decreased by about \$2.3 million, or 2.7%, between 2022/23 and 2023/24.

This was a decrease from about \$85.7 million to about \$83.4 million.

Revenue increased by

between 2022/23 and 2023/24. Total revenue was \$304.9 million in 2022/23 compared to \$315.3 million in 2023/24, a difference of \$10.4 million.

Total operating expenditures increased by

between 2022/23 and 2023/24. Operating expenditures increased by about \$18.5 million, from \$284.6 million to \$303.1 million.

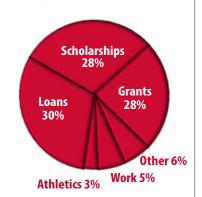

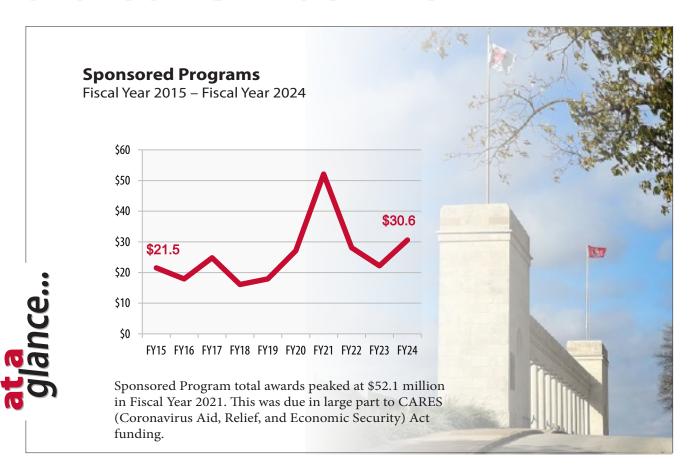
2024/25



Thirty-one percent of student financial assistance awarded was in the form of loans, with 70% of loan dollars being in the form of Stafford Loans. Scholarships made up 28% of total student financial assistance, up from 18% ten years ago. Twenty-eight percent of award dollars were in the form of grants, with the Federal Pell Grant making up 50% of grant dollars awarded.

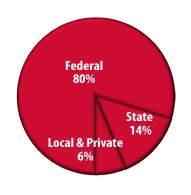

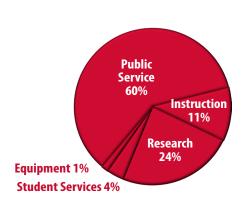
