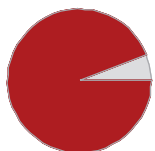
In Arts & Letters, **females** make up **65%** of the student population.

The majority, or **94%**, of Arts & Letters students are at the **undergraduate** level.

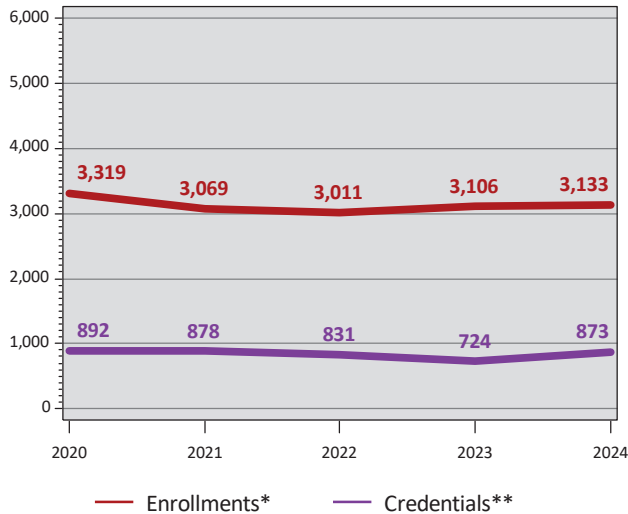
