

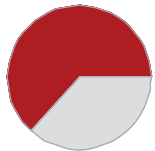

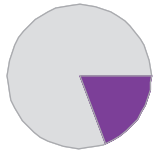

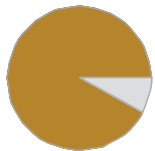
## Potter College of Arts & Letters Student Profile Fall 2018 - 2022



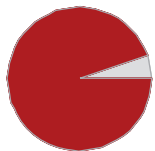
In Arts & Letters, **females** make up **63%** of the student population.
