

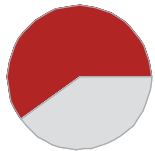

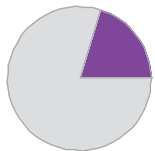


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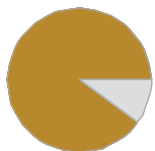
## Potter College of Arts & Letters Student Profile Fall 2013 - 2017



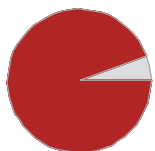
In Arts & Letters, **females** make up **60%** of the student population.
