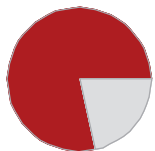




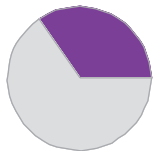

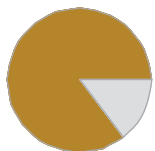
College of Health and Human Services Student Profile Fall 2020 - 2024



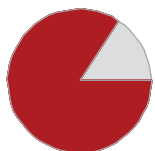
In Health and Human Services, **females** make up **78%** of the student population.

The majority, or **84%**, of Health and Human Services students are at the **undergraduate** level.

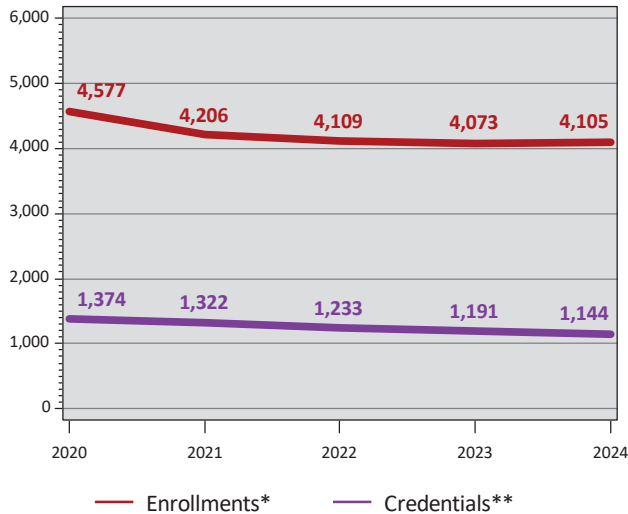
