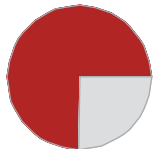




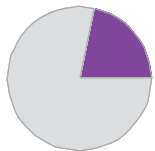

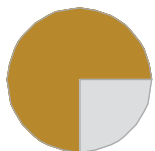
## College of Health and Human Services Student Profile Fall 2013 - 2017



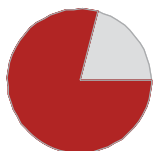
In Health and Human Services, **females** make up **75%** of the student population.

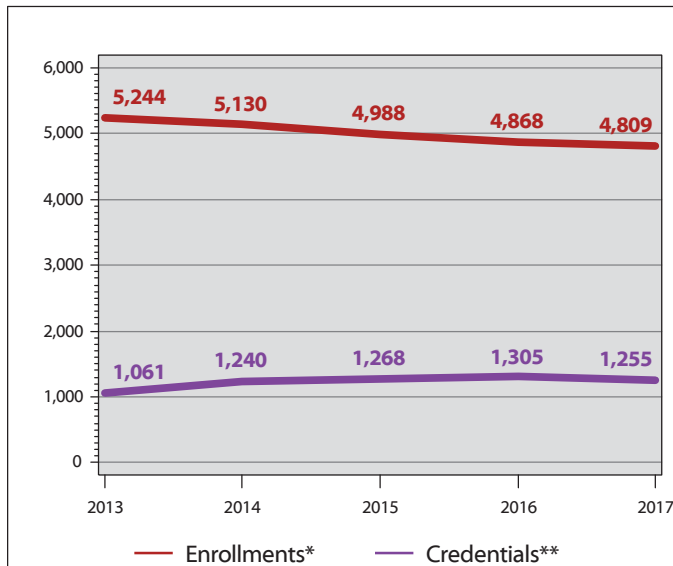
