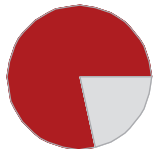




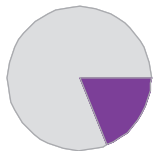

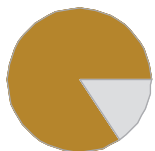
College of Health and Human Services Student Profile Fall 2018 - 2022



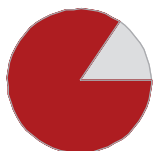
In Health and Human Services, **females** make up **79%** of the student population.
