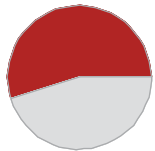




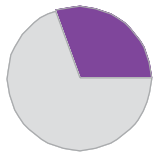

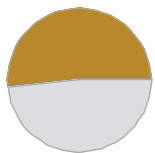
University College Student Profile Fall 2013 - 2017



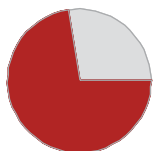
In University College, **females** make up **55%** of the student population.

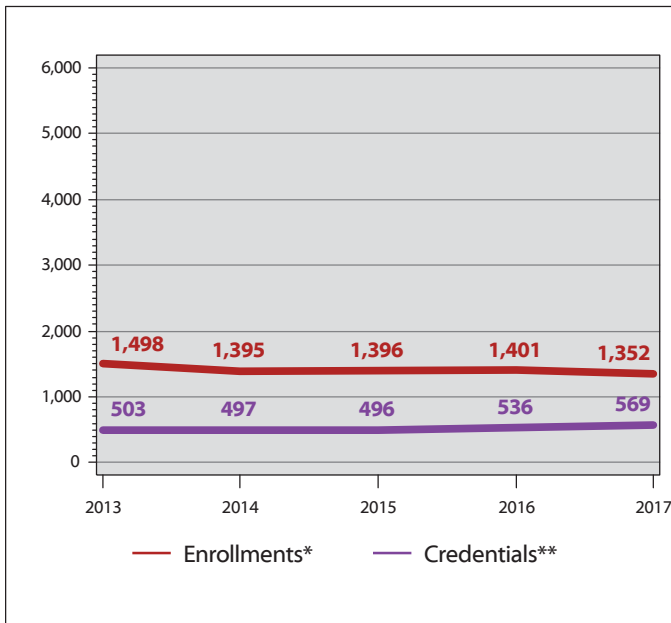
