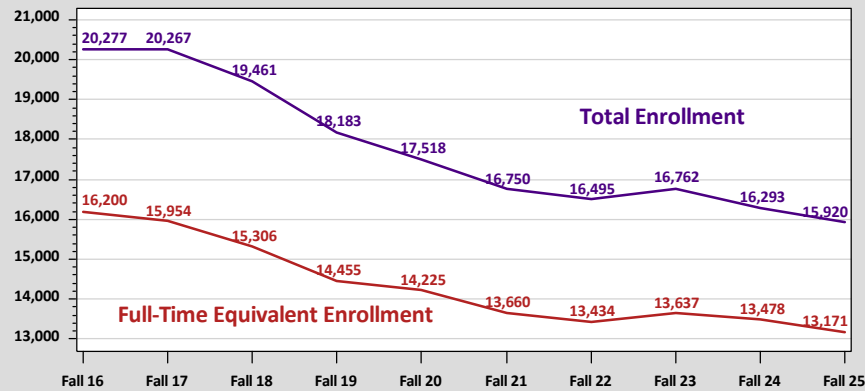




Ten-Year Enrollment Trend
