




Elizabethtown|Ft. Knox Course Enrollments




Fall 2016 Glasgow Regional Campus Enrollment Report




Fall 2016 Owensboro Regional Campus Enrollment Report



Owensboro Course Enrollments




Fall 2016 Course Enrollments by Type

How Enrollments Are Credited to Regional Campuses

Due to the close proximity of WKU's campuses, students often take courses at multiple campuses. Additionally, students take advantage of face-to-face, as well as distance learning opportunities. Therefore, students can rarely be classified as belonging to a single campus.

While not perfect, we have developed a methodology to credit the regional campuses with the students they most likely serve. The following table provides the specific courses credited to the regional campuses, along with course-taking scenarios that result in students and their enrollments being credited to the regional campuses. The methodology allows for a student to be counted at multiple regional campuses as well as the main campus. Therefore, the sum of the students will be greater than WKU's headcount enrollment.
