

## **Pre-Arrival Checklist**

You should have received your official acceptance letter and I-20 or DS-2019 from WKU. If you have not, please contact our admissions staff at <a href="mailto:iem@wku.edu">iem@wku.edu</a>.

- Pay SEVIS I-901 fee: Department of Homeland Security Form I-901
- Obtain an F-1 or J-1 student visa at your local US Embassy or Consulate General
- Arrange your travel to Nashville, Tennessee (Airport Code: BNA)
  - o **FALL:** Transportation provided free of charge on specific dates. Any dates before or after, you must arrange your own transportation.
  - o **SPRING:** Transportation provided free of charge on specific dates. Any dates before or after, you must arrange your own transportation.
  - **SUMMER:** Transportation to be secure by student.
    - Bowling Green Shuttle offers discounts to WKU students. Request a shuttle <u>here</u>.
- Confirm your arrival with WKU via iStart: http://bit.ly/2nWaCzK
  - o Login using you NetID and NetID password
    - If you do not know your NetID information, please login to your <u>WKU Accounts</u> for assistance.
  - o Confirm your arrival information beginning with the "Pre-Arrival" link on the left side of the page for the term you were admitted.
  - o Deadline to complete will be:
    - Fall: August 1
    - Spring: January 3
    - Summer: May 15
- Freshmen and undergraduate transfer students must attend the Topper Orientation Program to schedule classes.
  - o TOP information
- Prepare your immigration documents and pack them in your carry-on luggage.
  - These documents should include: passport, visa, and I-20/DS-2019.
- Download the orientation schedule from our website.
- Arrange housing

- Prepare funds for immediate needs.

- Review WKU's health insurance guidelines.
- Review campus and community <u>resources</u>.
- Packing and weather information.
  - o On-campus housing requires XL twin sheets. Local stores include:
