

## Major in Photojournalism- Photo Track 4-year plan

The following four-year grid is designed to help you plan your program in the Photojournalism Track. Every student will finish with a unique plan of his/her own depending on the minor area of study, electives selected, etc. This four-year chart is an example to help plan your degree program in consultation with your Photojournalism faculty advisor. Refer to the University catalog for additional information.

**Note:** To meet ACEJMC accreditation standards, students must complete 80 hours outside of the major including 65 hours of liberal arts and sciences. If the minor selected is not in a liberal arts or natural science subject (LAS), then the student should select LAS courses for all general electives and may need to take more hours than the University requirement of 128 hours for graduation.

130 hours total if minor is in a non-liberal arts/science subject.
