

Major in Photojournalism- 4-year plan Fall 2008 Catalog year revised 4/09

For students entering the University or declaring the major in fall 2008, the following four-year grid is designed to help you plan your degree in the Photojournalism program in consultation with your faculty advisor. Every student will finish with a unique plan of his/her own depending on the minor area of study, electives selected, etc. The information in this document will differ slightly from the University 2008 catalog, due to curriculum changes in course inventory.

Note: To meet ACEJMC accreditation standards, students must complete 80 hours outside of the major area of journalism and mass communication with no fewer than 65 semester hours of liberal arts and natural sciences. If the minor selected is not in a liberal arts or natural science subject (LAS), then the student should select LAS courses for all general electives and may need to take more hours than the University requirement of 120 hours for graduation.

120 hours total if (21 hour) minor is in a liberal arts/science subject.

Note: Expect over 120 hours total if minor is in a non-liberal arts or science subject. (See advisor)
