

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. How much is the fee for each student to attend the High School Leadership Conference?

- The High School Leadership Conference is \$30 per student. This fee covers breakfast, lunch, content materials, as well as parting gifts.
- This fee can be paid via check, or cash on the day of the conference, or it may be rendered after the conference.

2. What types of content will be covered during the High School Leadership Conference?

- We are still planning the 2021 speakers, but past sessions have included topics such as time management, post-graduation tips, college advice, study skills, leadership assessments, campus tours, Q&A sessions, etc.
- The exact sessions and speakers change year to year.

3. What grades is this conference geared towards?

- Because there is always a variety of breakout sessions for students to choose from the grade levels vary from 9th to 12th grade.
- Some sessions are more geared towards seniors, whereas some sessions could be geared more towards freshmen. However, students are encouraged to attend the breakout session they are the most interested in.

4. When can I register my students for the High School Leadership Conference?

- Registration for the HSLC 2021 Conference opens on Friday, July 30th and closes on Friday, September 3rd.
