CONDITIONS

1. The image copy is to be used only once and only for the purpose listed in the Permission Form. Subsequent or different uses must be applied for in writing and are subject to additional use fees.

2. Proper credit must be given. The following is the preferred credit line:
“Courtesy of Library Special Collections, Western Kentucky University” or “Courtesy of Library Special Collections, WKU”
3. In authorizing any publication, the Department does not surrender its own right to publish, or grant permission to others to publish. The above signed expressly assumes all responsibility for observing applicable laws of copyright, literary property, fair use, and libel and covenants and agrees to exonerate, indemnify and hold the library, the University, its Board of Regents, Officers, and Agents harmless for and on account of any and all loss, cost, damage or expense arising out of or in any way connected with the use which the above signed makes or suffers or permits to be made of the materials identified above.

SOCIAL MEDIA USE ADDENDUM:
