Students earning a 26 or higher on ACT Math, or 610 or higher on SAT Math, will earn credit for MATH 116.

** MATH 136 also requires a score of 10 or higher on the MPTE

The following scores will place a student directly into MATH 136: 27 or greater on ACT Math, 640 or higher on SAT Math, 15 or higher on KYOTE Calculus, or 76 or higher on ALEKS PPL.

KYOTE College Algebra scores directly correlate with MPE scores.

All placement scores expire after one year (KYOTE, MPE, ALEXS PPL, PARCC, Accuplacer).

One retake during the currency period is possible. The retake does not "reset the currency clock" and is taken in a proctored environment. Contact the Math Testing Center for more information.

ACT/SAT Scores expire after four years.
