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## WKU revising Masters of Education in Advanced Teacher Education

Western Kentucky University announced the redesign of its Masters of Education in Advanced Teacher Education degree.

The program will help teachers advance their rank, hone practices and secure additional teaching licensures, while reflecting and focusing on needs of communities, the college said.

Teachers in participating school districts may earn six credit hours of professional education through district partnerships with including the Fall 2021 New Teacher Academy.

Teachers eligible to host student teachers can earn a course fee waiver which may be applied toward program cost. Starting in 2021, newly licensed WKU alumni teachers will be enrolled in Classroom Management for First Year Teachers at no cost, earning three credit hours of professional education.
