## Admission Requirements for Master of Music Degree in Conducting: Choral

- 1. A baccalaureate degree in music from a NASM-accredited institution with a GPA of 2.75 or higher.
- 2. A completed application to the WKU Music Department
- 3. A completed application to the WKU Graduate School
- 4. Pre-screen audition materials submitted to the <u>Director of Choral Activities</u> via email before **December 1**:
  - a. A formal letter of intent to audition into the WKU Master of Music Program.
  - b. A current curriculum vitae.
  - c. Link to a 10–15-minute performance, from memory, of 2-3 solo vocal selections featuring a variety of styles and languages.
  - d. Link to 15 minute, unedited sample of your conducting work in a choral rehearsal. Please be sure that the camera shows your face and hands clearly.
  - e. An academic writing sample that demonstrates style and ability of approximately five pages in length, double-spaced. An academic paper from the undergraduate degree is acceptable. Any writing samples found to have been written with AI will be rejected.
- 5. Based on application materials, selected applicants will be asked to the WKU campus for an on-campus audition in **February** or **March**. Candidates will be assessed on their competency in the areas of:
  - a. Choral Conducting
  - b. Applied Instrument Performance
  - c. Written and Aural Music Theory
  - d. Keyboard Skills
  - e. Foreign Language Diction (French, German, and Italian)
  - f. Vocal Pedagogy

Incomplete applications and pre-screen audition materials will not be considered.
