

LPN to ASN Program - Transfer of Nursing Course(s)

The LPN to ASN Program abides by the transfer policies of the university. The WKU Transfer Center website includes transfer Requirements & Deadlines, Transfer Articulation, Types of Credit Accepted, How Will My Credits Transfer, and how to Petition WKU Departments for Transfer Credit Equivalencies, among other useful information. In the event a student requests transfer equivalency credit for a nursing course taken at another institution, the nursing course must have been taken within two years of admission to the nursing program, be from a regionally accredited college or university, have academic credit hours equivalent to or more than that of the equivalent ASN required nursing course, and be equivalent to the LPN to ASN Program nursing course. For students with academic credit for specialty nursing courses (Mental Health Nursing & Maternal Newborn Nursing) that do not meet these transfer requirements, the student has the option to attempt a clep exam for academic credit granted by the LPN to ASN Program. The student is responsible for all costs associated with clep exams.
