Education abroad is one of the most valuable investments you can make in your college experience. At WKU, we are committed to making study abroad accessible to all students. A few resources available to you include:

- Support Staff and Offices- In addition to SAGL, offices like Student Financial Assistance, Office of Scholar Development, Advising & Career Development Center, Passport Services, and more assist students with study abroad.
- Study Abroad Scholarships- Over \$200,000 is awarded to WKU students annually through WKU departments. Many program providers and external agencies offer additional scholarships.
- Institutional Scholarships- WKU merit scholarships and KEES money can generally be applied towards the cost of study abroad.
- Financial Aid- Most federal and state grants can be used to fund study abroad.
- Fundraising Guide- SAGL Student Representatives have developed a booklet of ideas for ways to raise money for study abroad.
