**Associate Degree Filing Procedures & Requirements**

This degree program form serves as an agreement between the University and the student regarding the course requirements for the Associate of Interdisciplinary Studies degree and is valid for five years from the date approved by the College Dean.

- This form is to be completed and filed during the first term of the student’s enrollment in this program.
- All changes made after the degree program has been approved must be filed on a Degree Program Change Form which can be obtained from the University College Dean’s Office.
- Indicate each transfer course by a check ( ✓ ) in the Tr. column. Use course numbers from the transfer institution.
- Program includes 25% of the minimum number of hours required in the degree program earned through instruction at WKU.

- One-third of the hours in each area of emphasis must be earned at WKU.
- Program includes minimum of 60 hours earned in courses numbered 100 or higher.
- Elective courses earned in excess of the required 60 (minimum) should not be listed on this form.
- Graduation with honors requires a minimum of 27 hours toward this associate degree be earned at WKU. A minimum 3.4 GPA must be earned overall and in courses taken at WKU.
- A 2.0 cumulative grade point average must be earned for all coursework presented in completion of the program; in all coursework completed at WKU; and in overall emphases hours.
- An Application for Graduation and \$50 fee must be filed.
