The Parents Advisory Council serves as the governing body of the WKU Parents Association, and is charged with ensuring the effectiveness of the Association in achieving its goals, establishing and enforcing policies for the Association, and allocating funds from the Parents Fund to support student directed initiatives.

The Council is comprised of 16-32 Bronze, Silver, or Gold Members of the Parents Association representing all four classes (freshman, sophomore, junior, senior). Members can apply, and are appointed to open positions by the Parent and Family Programs Coordinator and Vice President for Student Affairs, with the approval of the Council, as the parents and family members of graduating students rotate off the Council. Appointments are for at least one year, with a maximum equal to the number of years the Council member's student is enrolled at WKU.

Council members are required to attend two of three yearly meetings and one activity to maintain their Council positions. In addition, Council members are required to maintain at least a Bronze Membership with the Parents Association and make an additional gift to the Parents Fund.

# Responsibilities

**Advocate**— The Parents Advisory Council often serves as a sounding board, listening to new program ideas and campus initiatives, providing feedback to University staff and administrators. In addition, the PAC serves as the voice of the Parents Association, advocating the needs and concerns of parents and family members to University staff and administrators.

**Support**— Council members provide support by assisting in the planning and implementation of Parent and Family Programs events, engaging in programs, and assisting in fundraising efforts. Council members also provide support to the Association by reviewing New Member Applications and contributing to the Parent and Family Programs e-newsletter.

**Promote**—Council members are invited to represent the Association at new student recruitment and orientation events in the fall and spring, and promote involvement in the Association and Parents Advisory Council to other parents and family members of WKU students. Council members capitalize on opportunities to educate the parents and family members of current and prospective students about the benefits of attending WKU.

### **Expectations**

- Attend at least two of three Parents Advisory Council meetings per academic year,
- Assist with the planning and staffing of Parent and Family Programs events including Parent and Family Weekend,
- Identify and advocate needs and concerns of other WKU parents and family members to University staff and administrators,
- Support the Parents Fund by making an annual gift above your membership level,
- Further the goals of the Parents Association by assisting with fundraising efforts,
- Represent the Parents Association at new student recruitment and orientation events in the fall and spring,
- Promote the Parents Association and Parents Advisory Council to other parents and family members of WKU students,
- Interact with prospective students and their parents and family members in their local communities, and acquaint them with and highlight the benefits of attending WKU, and
- Serve on the Council for at least one year with a maximum service equal to the number of years their students are enrolled at WKU.

## **Required Qualifications**

- Have at least one student currently enrolled at WKU
- Maintain at least a Bronze Membership with the Parents Association
- Ability and willingness to meet expectations and carry out responsibilities outlined above
