

Thomas Nicholson is currently a Professor of Public Health at Western Kentucky University (WKU). He received a Ph.D. in Community Health Education from Southern Illinois University, an MPH from the University of Texas, and a M.A.Ed. in Counseling from WKU. He has published over 55 professional journal articles and presented over 115 research presentations at scientific meetings. His research interests include mental health, drug use and misuse and drug policy. He was formerly on the Board of Directors of the National Association for Public Health Policy and Chair of their Council on Illicit Drugs. He coordinated the DRUGNET Study, an on-line survey of adult drug users, which is the most extensive descriptive study of nonabusive users to date.
