Note 1: Full-time students are undergraduates who enroll in 12 hours or more of course work during the Fall and Spring terms. The full-time tuition rate applies to undergraduate students taking 12-18 credit hours (either exclusively on-campus or a combination of on-campus and distance learning). An additional per credit hour fee equivalent to the per hour tuition rate will be charged to undergraduate students enrolled in more than 18 credit hours.

Note 2: Graduate tuition and fees are assessed per credit hour based upon the course (i.e. on-campus or distance learning). Kentucky/Multi-state P-12 Educator, KCTCS EdD, Local Government Employee Discount Program, DNP, and DPT do not have a distance learning rate. Assessed as approved.

Note 3: Students enrolled **exclusively** in distance learning courses (courses with a campus code of "W") will be assessed the **Distance Learning** course rate regardless of residency or the number of hours enrolled. There is no full-time distance learning rate.

Tuition and fees will be assessed and available for review on TopNet in mid-July for the fall semester and mid-November for the spring semester.
